Headline Commentary

Management Information are committed and focused on fulfilling our obligation to Kent's young people during these difficult times. We will continue to provide all necessary analysis to help Managers and Key Workers achieve this goal.

The percentage of not knowns has continued to reduce this month as the ILR and NAS data is matched to the Not Knowns list. The Not Known percentage dropped from last month by 0.3 percentage points.

The NEET population is currently at 3.7% compared 3.2% same time last year, and our Not Knowns are at 2.6%, down from 2.9% last month. The Participation rate has improved again to 90.1%, up from 89.6% last month, this is consistent compared with the same point last year.

District performance for NEET varies from 2.3% in Tunbridge Wells to 4.9% In Swale and Folkestone and Hythe. District performance for Not Knowns is more varied, and ranges from 1.7% in Tunbridge Wells to 3.5% in Thanet.

The Local Authority has a statutory duty to collect data from all education establishments regarding offers they have made to 16-and 17-year olds from September. It is an important part of our planning and transition support offer. Enabling us to identify those at-risk of NEET, gaps in local provision and to work alongside you in supporting our most vulnerable young people.

The process in place to collect this data is a partnership between MI, The Education People's Skills and Employability service and Kent schools and colleges. Despite the challenging times we find ourselves in, we are endeavouring to complete this process as usual. However, some of the timings have changed, please see below:
