Our school farm

We can offer a range of enrichment activities that are suitable for all learner. Sessions can be tailored for any Key Stage and for special schools or children with disabilities.

During their time on the farm children can get involved with handling and animal interaction, feeding the animals, talks and activities about animal welfare, horticulture, pond dipping, work with exotic animals, art and photography.









We can cover all curriculum links using the farm and our environmental centre such as: Mathematics — feeding ratios, weights and measures Science — life cycles, reproduction English — poetry and story telling History — farming through the years, dig for victory Geography — soil types, seasons DT and Art — designing animal habitats

Climbing Wall

10 metre high climbing wall with bottom roping, bouldering, and multi grade climbs Group sessions for schools available at selected times throughout the term.

Max numbers 12 per group


Fully instructed sessions, harnesses and helmets provided.

Forest School

Forest School sessions are run either on our school site or from 100 acres of woodland just outside Great Chart.

Sessions cover a range of practical activities including:

- Fire lighting
- Den building
- Team challenges
- Making charcoal
- Plant and tree identification
- Water purification
- Woodworking



Forest School helps build confidence, self-esteem, positive relationships and team work.
